Oak Creek Water is seeking candidates to fill the Distribution Operator I / II position. The ideal candidate must be a self-starter and highly motivated with the ability to work independently and as a team. The position performs a variety of duties in the operation, installation, maintenance and repair of water distribution facility systems, including reading meters, responding to customer complaints, repairing main and service line leaks and breaks; installing, repairing and maintaining water system infrastructure such as water mains, valves, meter connections, and appurtenances; and other duties. Salary is commensurate with experience. Benefits package includes paid vacation and holidays.

Required:

- State of Arizona ADEQ Water Distribution Operator Certificate Grade I or II, or must obtain Grade 1 certification within one year of employment
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Valid Arizona Driver's License; proof of good driving record as evidenced by freedom from multiple or serious traffic violations or accidents for at least three (3) years duration
- Requires working outside in a variety of environmental extremes such as heat, cold, rain, snow, mud, and dust
- Ability to move heavy objects (50 pounds or more)
- Requires walking for prolonged periods which may include walking over rough uneven or rocky surfaces
- Occasional, weekends, holidays and evenings may be required
- Basic Computer Skills
- Excellent Customer Service
- Must communicate effectively oral and written

Desirable:

- Two (2) years of experience in public water utility; or an equivalent combination of education and experience in maintenance / construction work.

Since this position is considered a “first responder” during emergency conditions, candidates must live within 45 minutes travel time of the Company’s Yard in West Sedona, AZ The successful candidate must pass a criminal background, previous employment, and MVD checks, pre-employment physical exam, drug screen and alcohol test.
